

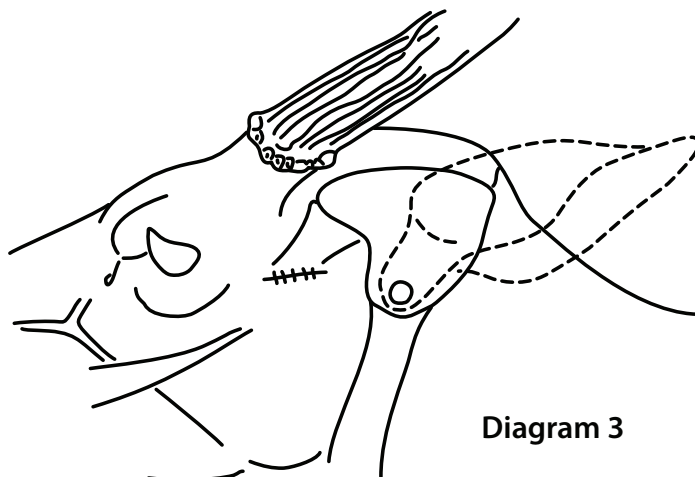
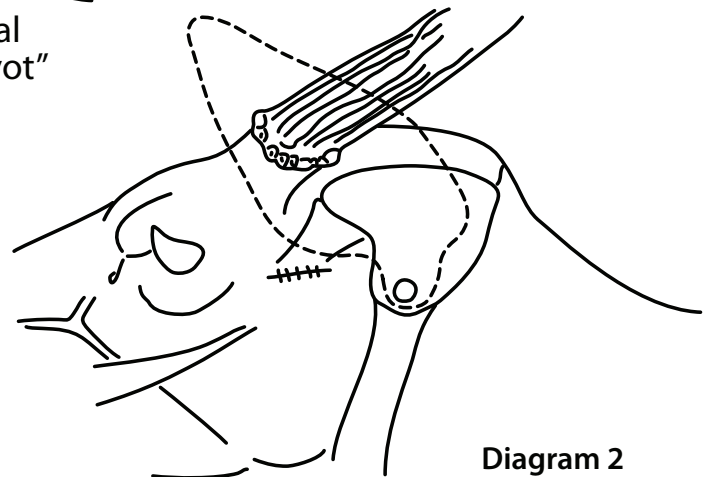
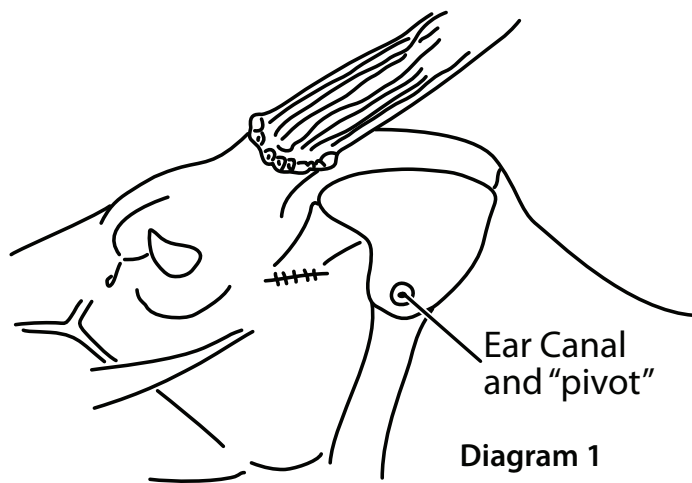

I. Three aspects that work together: eyes, ears, and antler set

II. 4 Point "attachment:"

- A. The ear canal is the base point of attachment from which the ear pivots positions (see diagrams 1, 2, 3).

- C. "Bulb" of ear (see diagram 4, #3).

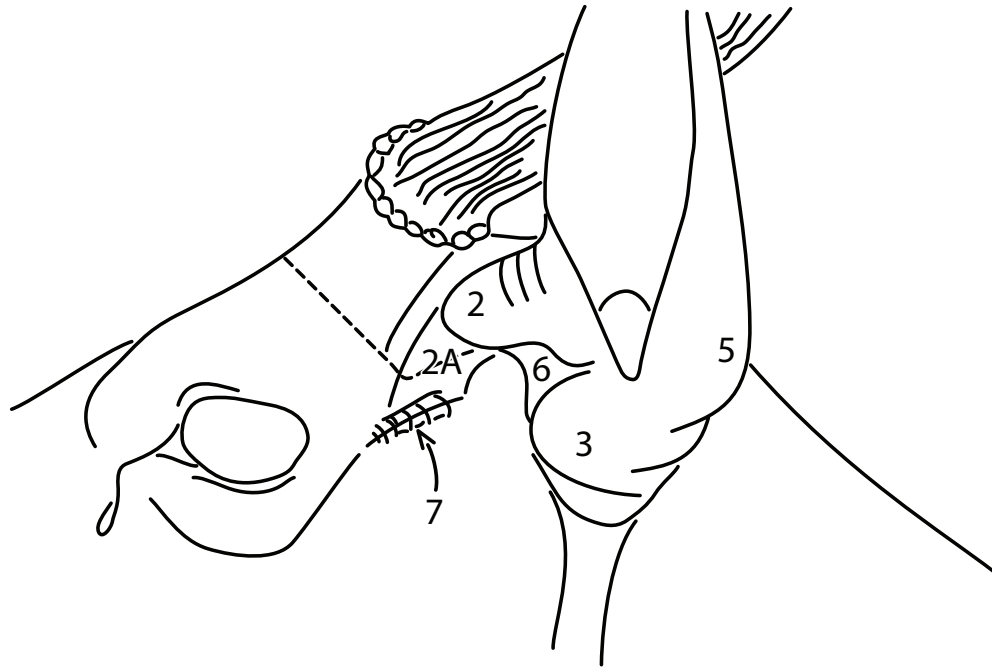

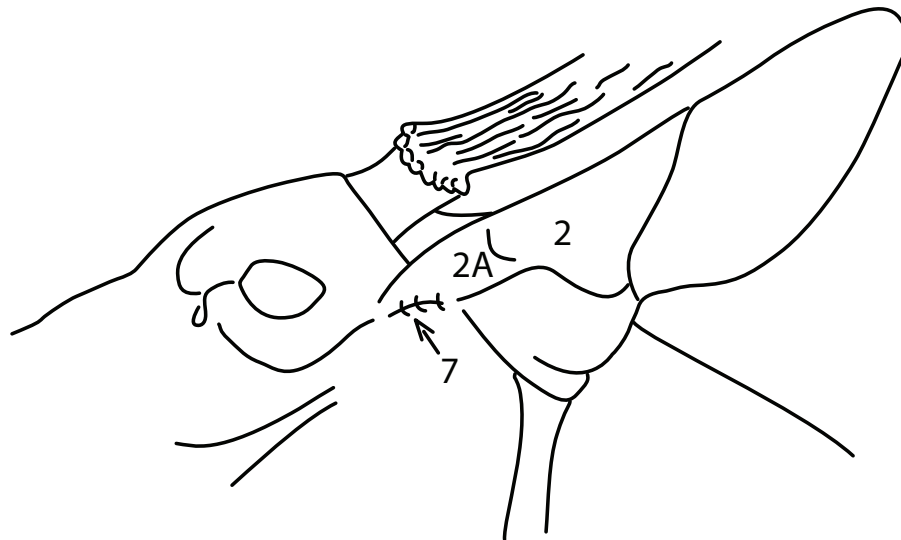

- D. Cervical auricul(s) attach to the center of the skull and the cervical ligament.

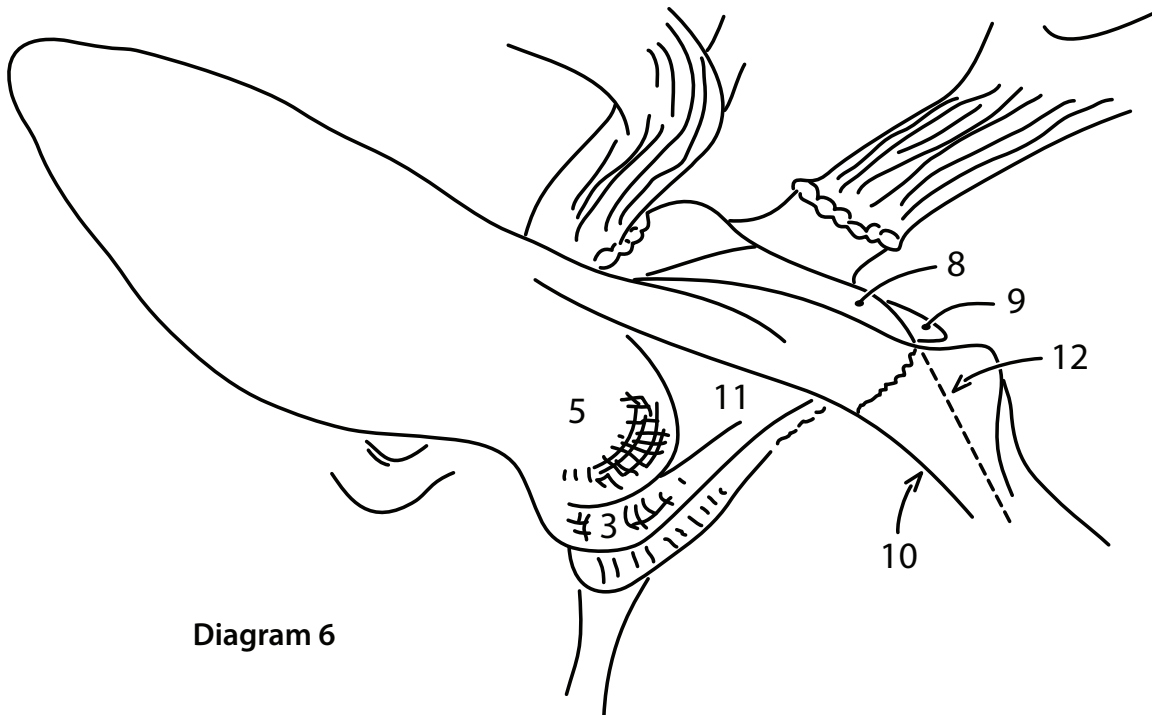
